If you use many special fonts, please convert the document to PDF with Adobe Acrobat (see below, and also the Author Gateway's Quickguide: <a href="http://authors.elsevier.com">http://authors.elsevier.com</a>). Please place figures in a logical place within the document. See also the section on <a href="http://authors.elsevier.com">Preparation of electronic illustrations</a> on the same website. To avoid unnecessary errors you are strongly advised to use the "spellchecker" function of your word processor.

## LaTeX files

Please use a LaTeX setup that uses Type 1 fonts instead of the sometimes default bitmap fonts (Type 3, or pk fonts). - 6 pages for a Session Summary (to be written by each couple of conveners)
- 3 pages for a Parallel talk
- 10 pages for the Concluding Talk
